Primary contributing factors for slip, trips, falls:

- Ice+Snow
- Water+Liquid
- Getting in/out of vehicle
- Going up/down steps and stairs



Fall from 8' ladder in 2012: Claim cost =

\$371,433°

Slipped on ice in 2011: Claim cost =

\$264,928¹

An unrestrained adult fall from standing has been shown to produce **12x's more force** than what is required to cause a simple skull fracture.²
