Assessment Criteria: Responses

Please respond to each criteria in the field provided. Please keep your responses brief – generally allow about a half single-spaced page (250 words) for each.

1. Describe the Nominee’s commitment to workplace health and safety:
 - a. Within a workplace, describe how the Nominee actively supports and fosters the commitment of management to occupational health and safety (OHS) and injury management (including return-to-work) programs.
 - b. Describe how the Nominee demonstrates impact to continued, real improvements in the health and safety culture of Nova Scotia.
2. Describe how the Nominee effected change toward a demonstrated improvement in health and safety in a workplace or workplaces, an industry, or the workplace safety culture across Nova Scotia?
3. Describe the broader application or impact – or potential for such – of the Nominee’s leadership across other workplaces and/or to the industry(ies)?

Nomination **must** also include:

- Evidence of professional designation(s) in the field of safety (i.e. CRSP, CHSC, ROH, OHN, etc.)
- Copy of job description to confirm nominee is in a dedicated OHS role
- Where Nominee is a full-time employee, a letter from the employer supporting this nomination
- Supporting letter(s) from colleagues – or, in the case of an independent safety consultant, supporting letters from customers/clients

- Objective evidence to validate stated accomplishments

Award finalists will be visited by members of the judging panel to verify claims made in the proposals and gain further context.
